## Two One-Day Trainings

# Home and Community Based Settings (HCBS) – What It Means For Our Work

Geared for anyone involved in providing services to people with intellectual or developmental disabilities through the HCBS Waiver.

This training will focus on understanding and implementing:

- New HCBS Requirements
- Requirements for Provider Owned/Controlled Residential Settings
- New Person-Centered Service Plan Process and Documentation Requirements

**Capacity**: Class is limited to 40 people. Host agency may reserve as many slots as requested, but a minimum of 15.

**Equipment and setup**: A conference room with seating for participants and a projector (CQL staff will have their laptop). The CQL staff may also ask for flip charts.

**Time**: 9 am – 3:30 pm, with an hour and fifteen minute break for lunch.

#### Introduction to Personal Outcome Measures®

Provides an overview of what the **Personal Outcome Measures**® are, how they work and why they are essential. During this one-day overview of POMs, participants will gain an understanding of the meaning and application of the POMs through interactive participation and group activities.

**Capacity**: Class is limited to 40 people. Host agency may reserve as many slots as requested, but a minimum of 15.

**Equipment and setup**: A conference room with seating for participants and a projector (CQL staff will have their laptop). The CQL staff may also ask for flip charts.

**Time**: 9 am – 3 pm, with an hour break for lunch.

## **Four-Day Training**

# Personal Outcome Measures® Assessment Workshop

This workshop is designed to assist participants in learning to use CQL's Personal Outcome Measures® for assessment and enhancement of quality and consistency in services. The workshop is an intensive

experience and pre-workshop preparation is important to accomplishing the overall goal. The host organization will appoint one person to coordinate the workshop arrangements. The CQL trainer will work with this person to adopt the workshop format to the unique characteristics of the organization and participants.

**Capacity:** Workshop is limited to 12 participants. 12 Interviews will be conducted. Please Note: Host agency is responsible for coordinating 12 different interviews during the course of the training: Six on Day 1 and six on Day 3.

The host agency may reserve six of the 12 participant slots for their staff in the 4-day session, and possible more depending on other provider interest. This course does not certify POMs interviewers, but can be used by agencies as part of that process. Dates will be coordinated with interested agencies.
